

Rifle-Pistol Range, Short-Range Days

(Weather permitting)

As of November 26, 2023, the Rifle-Pistol range will be supporting a "Short-Range Day" every forth Sunday of the month. The Chapter will also continue to offer short-range time on the fifth Sunday of months that have them. The expanded "Short-Range Day" program is to accommodate handgun shooters who want to practice at distances less than 25 yards with the targets set up downrange near the berm at the range 100-yard line. The firing line is delineated back 10 yards with tables. The shooting area is on gravel/dirt/grass, so plan accordingly (it is also not covered).

All range procedures remain the same for the handling and use of firearms during short-range times. For more information, always check with the Range Safety Officer (RSO) on duty.

NOTE

- Range hours will be the same as normal Sunday hours.
 - o Check Rifle-Pistol Web page for operating hours.
- In the event of rain (forecasted or actual), soggy, or snow-covered range area, Short Range Day may be cancelled.
 - The decision is up to the RSOs to make and may happen with short notice or without notice on the Chapter Web site.
- In the event of cancellation, the range converts back to the normal shooting, under the overhang-covered firing line and targets will be starting at 25 yards.
- Rifle and black powder shooters will be allowed to use the range.
