- Mr. Chidester recommends the following 3 new policies to be implemented on the Rifle Pistol Range:
 - No smoking or vaping on the rifle pistol range during operating hours. Smoking will be permitted outside the rifle pistol range entrance gate.
 - There must be at least a two second interval between trigger pulls. Exceptions will be granted for bullseye matches, NOVA Sharpshooters, formal training, and competition events.
 - For members of the NOVA Sharpshooters and Bulls Eye Pistol shooters, a low ready position is permitted on the rifle/pistol range during the firing process or resting between shots. In the low ready position, the pistol is pointed towards the ground but forward of the firing line. In the ready position, the shooter's arm must point downward at an angle of not greater than 45 degrees from the vertical. The arm with the pistol must not be pointed at the ground within the forward edge of the firing point. At the discretion of the RSO, other shooters may use this shooting position; however, if, in the RSO's opinion, the shooter is acting in an unsafe manner or causes an accidental and unintentional discharge into the ground, the RSO may revoke permission to use this position.
