3. PRESIDENT'S TIME

• Dr. Dobbins presented the Chapter's annual scholarship to Grant Miller Beer from Yorktown High School, who plans to major in marine fisheries conservation at Virginia Tech. A complimentary student membership was also awarded to Mr. Grant.

4. MINUTES/CORRESPONDENCE

• Minutes from the May 2022 General Membership Meeting were available for all to review. The minutes were approved as written.

5. TREASURER'S REPORT

- Mr. Crisman presented the Budget Report through the end of May 2022 to the Membership.
 - Income: \$384,976.07
 - Expenditures: \$104,393.13
 - Budget Remaining: \$280,582.94

6. MEMBERSHIP UPDATE

- Mr. Crandall provided an update on status of the Membership, stating that the Chapter currently has 2,185 memberships accounted for, and that the next New Member Orientation will be on August 6, 2022.
- Mr. Crandall moved to accept the candidates from the June New Member Orientation (those in attendance and those who were not able to attend) be voted into the Chapter. The motion was adopted, and 15 new members were admitted to the Chapter.

7. SPECIAL COMMITTES

- Air Range
 - Mr. Kuck that a new lock has been installed at the Air Range, and that he is currently working on getting it programmed.
 - There was a clinic last week held by Coach Soren Butler from Georgia Southern and two of his NCAA athletes.
 - The Air Range is open Mondays and Fridays at 5:30PM for three relays. Please use SignupGenius to reserve a lane. There are opportunities for new shooters to learn air rifle, all ages are welcome.
 - Mr. Kuck stated that Oscar Starz runs smallbore events on Friday evenings at Rifle/Pistol from 5:00PM until sunset. He has loaner rifles, but please bring your own ammunition. We also have the ability to work with handicapped shooters and Wounded Warriors.

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- Awards and Grants
 - Ms. Meara stated that the Chapter has applied for three National level IWLA awards, which would be presented at the National Convention in July if awarded.
- Building & Grounds
 - Mr. Rose provided an update on Buildings and Grounds activities.
 - Shotgun clubhouse renovations starting next month, please plan for some disruptions to operations. Check website calendar for closure dates.
 - Tick preventer was recently purchased and will be applied to the Chapter property soon.
 - A few dead and/or dying trees were recently removed from the Rifle/Pistol berm.
 - The Chapter road is in rough shape, and we are trying to acquire 50 loads of millings for repairs.
 - Had a meeting last week with the architectural firm for the Rifle/Pistol baffle project. Looking at building the baffles offsite and using a crane to install them to reduce range downtime.
 - Caretaker is on vacation and will be back in July. Please see Mr. Rose if you have any questions or problems.
 - Mr. Kuck informed those in attendance that the Chapter received a donated trailer from a member. It has been refurbished and is available for use on the Chapter property.

 - Ms. Meara stated an eBlast is sent out at the start of each month with important Chapter updates.
- Conservation

 - Ms. Meara stated that we have a great schedule of classes this year, with about 27 classes taught each year.

 - o Mr. Riemer stated that the ranges are in great shape, and two work parties recently provided upkeep.
 - Throughout the year there are volunteering opportunities at the Field Archery range for cleaning.

 - The Field Archery range hosts Archery 101 and 201 classes frequently for adults and children.
 - Mr. Riemer reminded those in attendance that broadheads are only allowed on the broadhead targets, and crossbows are only allowed at the crossbow station.
- Rifle/Pistol
 - o Ms. Meara informed those in attendance that Mr. Landry is the new Rifle/Pistol director.
- Skeet/Trap
 - Ms. Meara stated that the recent Crush'n Clays charity event was a success, and they are still counting to see how much will be donated to St. Jude's Children's Research Hospital. Over \$400,000 has been donated over the past 23 years.
- Target Archery
 - Mr. Del Vecchio stated that there are JOAD and Archery Development courses (for youth and adults) available.
 - Broadheads and crossbows are not allowed at the Olympic archery range.
 - Three classes (adult, first year, and second year) are currently being offered, which are the same programs offered by the Olympic training facility in Colorado Springs.
- Youth
 - Mr. Turner stated that the Youth Chapter has approximately 250 members, and that all members participate in Chapter activities.
 - The Junior Chapter recently sponsored a swap meet on June 4th, all items for sale were relevant to junior programs. The swap meet was well attended.
