### 4. MINUTES/CORRESPONDENCE

• Minutes from the June 2022 General Membership Meeting were available for all to review. The minutes were amended to reflect that Mr. Grant Miller was the recipient of the annual scholarship and not Mr. Grant Miller Beer. The minutes were approved as amended.

# 5. TREASURER'S REPORT

Mr. Crisman presented the Budget Report through the end of June 2022 to the Membership.

Income: \$390,956.79
 Expenditures: \$125,635.98
 Budget Remaining: \$265,320.81

• Mr. Starz inquired if \$25,000 in monthly expenditures was normal or cause for concern. Mr. Crisman stated that there were many large expenditures in June, including donations and insurance payments. Mr. Crisman stated that the expenditures were not cause for concern.

### 6. MEMBERSHIP UPDATE

- Mr. Gagnon moved that the candidate from the July New Member Orientation be voted into the Chapter. The motion was adopted, and one new member was admitted to the Chapter.
- Mr. Crandall provided an update on status of the Membership, stating that the Chapter currently has 2,187 memberships accounted for, and that the next New Member Orientation will be on August 6, 2022.
- Mr. Crandall stated that volunteers have contributed over 2,000 hours of volunteer work to the Chapter this year, and that his goal is to have 4,000 hours for the year.
- A member asked if the Chapter would have a recruiting table at the gun show this weekend. Mr. Randy Hancock stated that he will be setting up the table at the gun show on Thursday.
- A member asked if we knew how many members of the Chapter were military or retired military. Mr. Crandall stated that the Chapter does not maintain those records.

- Building & Grounds
  - o Mr. Kuck stated that tick insecticide has been applied to the fields at Skeet/Trap and Rifle/Pistol.
