4. MINUTES/CORRESPONDENCE

Minutes from the March 2023 General Membership Meeting were available for all to review. The minutes were approved as written.

5. TREASURER'S REPORT

Mr. Crisman presented the Budget Report, year to date, to the Membership.

o Income: \$309,373.81 0 Expenditures: \$73,704.75 Budget Remaining: \$235,669.06

- Mr. Starz inquired about the status of ensuring all of our bank deposits are FDIC insured. Mr. Crisman stated that he is still working on a solution to ensure that all of the chapters liquid assets are FDIC insured.
- A member asked if the percentage of our budgeted income is normal for this time of year. Mr. Crisman stated that the current income is normal for this time of year.

6. MEMBERSHIP UPDATE

Mr. Gagnon provided the monthly membership updated for Mr. Crandall.

• Mr. Gagnon moved to accept the candidates from the March New Member Orientations (those in attendance and those who were not able to attend) be voted into the Chapter. The motion was adopted, and 21 new members were admitted to the Chapter.

7. SPECIAL COMMITTES

Air Range

- Mr. Kuck stated that more than 15 youth from the Chapter were participating in the Junior Olympics in Colorado Springs, competing in air rifle, smallbore rifle, smallbore pistol, and Paralympic rifle.
- Mr. Kuck stated that Victoria Leppert, a senior at Lake Braddock High School last year, was the 2023 Junior Olympic Champion in Women's Air Rifle. Ms. Leppert is now attending the Air Force Academy.
- Mr. Kuck stated that Air Range is currently running a raffle for two .22 rifles. The raffles

• Buildings & Grounds

- o Mr. Rose stated that the pond will be closed for fishing starting on Thursday, April 20, until after the disabled picnic on May 6. The pond will reopen on May 7. All state fishing laws are followed at the pond.
- There is a lot of algae in the pond, and he is currently working on finding a solution.
- o Numerous trees have fallen recently, and are being cleaned up.
- A potential Eagle Scout is preparing a project proposal to remove invasive species at the Chapter.
