 - Mr. Rose provided the membership update for Mr. Crandall. There are currently 2,131 active memberships. There will not be a New Member Orientation (NMO) in July. Registration for the August NMO is full, and the September NMO is filling up.
 - 148 members volunteered over 850 hours recently.

- Air Range
 - There will be a clinic at the Air Range from July 24-28, 2023, with coaches from Georgia Southern and Memphis coaching.
- Buildings & Grounds
 - Mr. Rose provided an update on current Buildings & Grounds activities. We are working on getting stone for repairing the walkways at Skeet/Trap.
 - Ms. Meara stated that she is working on getting asphalt millings to repair the Chapter roads.
- Communication
