• Range Badge:

• All Members are required to display their range badge when they access/use ALL Chapter ranges (firearm, air range, and archery). Use of the range will be denied if you do not have it displayed. If you have lost your range badge, please contact the membership office to purchase a replacement badge.

• Speed limit: 10 MPH.

- o Per Chapter Ground Rules and posted signs.
- This is to ensure the safety of our members, guests, and wildlife.
- o Chapter has purchased a radar gun to assist in checking for speeders.
- Facility-Use Requests Looking for a place to hold an event or to camp overnight with your family? See the <u>Facility-Use Request</u> page on our Web site for information/procedures on how to make a request.
- Chapter Property (Pond, Picnic, and Camping Areas) All trash must be cleared and removed. Do not burn cans or bottles. You must clean up after use of the Chapter grounds/facilities.
- Gilbert's Pond Fishing policy Operating with Catch & Release Policy in effect. The Chapter follows all <u>Department of Wildlife Resources (DWR)</u> regulations.
- Animal Protection The Chapter grounds are considered a wildlife sanctuary and hunting is strictly prohibited. All animals are protected and are not to be harmed in any way. Anyone found to be harming wildlife on the Chapter grounds will be brought before the board of directors for disciplinary action.
- Chapter Dumpsters Please remember the dumpsters located on the Chapter property are for Chapter use only, not your personal use. Anyone caught dumping their personal trash in a Chapter dumpster will be brought before the board of directors for disciplinary action.
