

Field Archery

Update for Phase 3 (as of August 12, 2020)

***Due to Coronavirus (COVID-19) Pandemic ALL Executive Order (EO) Personal Protection Equipment (PPE) requirements are in effect at the chapter. Masks are required to enter any of the buildings. Please maintain Social Distancing.**

- Clubhouse –Cooking is allowed
 - Anyone using the kitchen is required to disinfect all surfaces after use. Cleaning supplies will be provided
- Guests are allowed.
- Max people to be in the indoor archery range is twelve. No more than six archers shooting from the shooting line at any one time maintaining social distancing.
- Archery club house a max of ten people inside maintaining social distancing.
- Cub Run Archers may hold monthly meetings in the indoor range. The range must be set up for social distancing and masks need to be worn. Meetings may be held outside when weather permits.
- Outdoor archery shoots may be held not to exceed fifty shooters. No food may be sold, only bottled water.
- 101 archery class may be scheduled with a max of ten attending plus two instructors.
- No Indoor tournament shoots may take place.

(As of June 12, 2020)

Phase 2

- The indoor archery range would reopen with a limit of four shooters using the range to maintain social distancing.
- Archery clubhouse may not have more than five people inside to maintain social distancing. No cooking may take place, coffee may be brewed.
- Cub Run Archers may hold monthly meetings in the indoor archery range set up for social distancing or outside. No meetings to be held in the archery clubhouse.
- Outdoor archery shoots may be held not to exceed fifty people, no food may be sold only bottled water.
- 101 archery class may be scheduled with a max of ten attending plus instructors all maintaining social distancing.
- IBEP archery class may be scheduled with a max of ten attending plus instructors all maintaining social distancing.
- VBA outdoor shoots may be held with a max of fifty shooters participating in the event.

Phase 1

In reopening field archery for phase one the outdoor ranges would be open with a large sign posted social distancing is in place. I would like to be able to continue with holding Fairfax County Qualifying. The last Sunday the chapter was open we qualified seven people for the county archery program and was able to accomplish that with everyone staying in a safe distance. Since our county qualifiers are chapter volunteers it would be up to each individual if they wanted to participate. Hoffman Archery has not stopped qualifying for the county. Also I have been told qualifying is being held at Prince William IWLA. The indoor range and club house would remain closed. We both know a few members would use their key to use the restroom so be it. The Cub Run Board members could hold a monthly meeting of no more than ten members outside if they choose too.
