The IWLA National Conservation Scholarship supports rising junior and senior college undergraduates from recognized conservation or environment-related degree programs. These degree programs may include (but are not limited to) environmental science, natural resource management, forestry, wildlife, fisheries, parks and recreation, range management, and other related sciences such as ecology, biology (conservation/field/marine), geology, hydrology, and zoology.

Category #1: Previous IWLA Chapter/Division Scholarship recipient. Category #2: Current IWLA member OR child/grandchild of a current IWLA member.

Each scholarship category includes a **\$2,500** scholarship and a one-year IWLA student membership.
