

ARL-FX Shotgun Range

Update for Phase 3 (as of September 11, 2020)

***Due to Coronavirus (COVID-19) Pandemic ALL Executive Order (EO) Personal Protection Equipment (PPE) requirements are in effect at the chapter. Masks are required to enter any of the buildings. Please maintain Social Distancing.**

- HOURS – Normal schedule. (See website for days and hour of operation)
- Guests are allowed at the Shotgun Range
- Clubhouse – clubhouse is **OPEN**
 - Cooking is allowed
 - Coffee brewing is allowed
 - Limited number of individuals in field house (Must follow COVID-19 requirements for social distancing)

(as of August 2020)

- HOURS – we will return to our **NEAR** normal schedule. (See website for days and hour of operation)
- Clubhouse – clubhouse is open to conduct signups, use the bathroom and make payment for your targets only. Maintain social distancing and leave as soon you are done with your business.
 - No cooking allowed
 - No coffee brewing
 - No conversations conducted in the field house

Guests are allowed at the Shotgun Range starting Phase 2

Restart plan for Shotgun (As of May 16, 2020)

The Range officers (RSO) are responsible for the enforcement of ALL SAFETY and RANGE rules.

RSO Authority:

RSO's will issue a verbal warning for first infractions of SAFETY or RANGE rules. Additional infractions will result in additional actions.

- The Range Officer on duty has the authority to:
 - REMOVE any person from the facility for any infraction
 - CLOSE a shooting Field
 - OR CLOSE the entire facility

SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCE RANGE RULES

General procedures

- Social Distancing — anyone visiting the Shotgun Range must adhere to the current State and Federal guidelines for Social Distancing.
- Bring own chair (to sit near your vehicle waiting to shoot)
- Field house porch – ONE WAY TRAFFIC
- Field house access – back door ONLY (for restroom and hand washing ONLY)
- No cooking no food or drinks in the clubhouse or on the grill.
- Bathroom waiting line is limited to 1 person waiting indoors.
- Bathroom cleaning is the responsibility of the person about to use/going into the facility. Cleaning and disinfecting supplies will be supplied by the Range
- Preferred Payment methods
 - Checks
 - Exact change
- Opening Procedure changes
 - Fields 2 and 4 will be opened for TRAP
 - Fields 1 and 3 will be opened for SKEET
 - Sign IN sheet should be posted on the porch
 - NO GUESTS are allowed (family members of guests are OK)
 - BADGE ENFORCEMENT REQUIRED. Members MUST display their current Range Badge in order to use the facilities.
- Reloading of targets
 - Targets will be reloaded after each squad has finished their shooting. Reloading is the responsibility of the (squad) who have just completed their shooting. Disposable gloves will be distributed by the Range Officer.
 - No more than 1 individual per house
 - Reloaders are required to wear disposable gloves and masks. Available in the clubhouse.
 - The range officer may ask you to help reload boxes of targets as the situation arises.

Skeet Procedures

- Skeet squads are limited to TWO rounds per squad. The RSO has the authority to waive this
- At the discretion of the Range Officer Skeet squads are limited to 4 shooters and 1 puller. During busy times AND/OR at the discretion of the RSO, Sign Up sheets will be issued.
- Squads are required to have a volunteer to pull for the squad up (no passing of the button)
- Disposable gloves required for the puller. Available in the clubhouse or through the RSO.
- No more than 2 rounds per squad. Squads can then sign up for additional times later in the day AFTER everyone has a chance to shoot.

Trap Procedures

- Squads limited to 5 shooters
- Only 1 squad allowed to wait in the shotgun pavilion (maintain social distancing)
- Callers are placed at the beginning of the day. If you feel you must move a caller, use a wipe after use
- Caller button use should be limited to the squadleader. Squadleader should use gloves
- Squads are limited to 2 rounds with no break in between rounds

- Squads must reload after completing their second round (disposable gloves required)

Stays the same

- Social Distancing (on and off the fields)
- One way traffic on Porch
- Disinfectant and gloves available at each field (use yellow buckets)
- GLOVES are required for reloading ALL fields.
- Skeet squads require all pullers to be wearing gloves. Skeet button should be sanitized after each round of Skeet.
- Use writing materials once Then move to the dirty cup. (If you have a chance during your shift, please use the disinfectant and some paper towels to clean the dirty pencil cup and move them into the clean cup.)

Changes

- Clubhouse – clubhouse is open to conduct signups, use the bathroom and make payment for your targets only. Maintain social distancing and leave as soon you are done with your business.
 - o No cooking allowed
 - o No coffee brewing
 - o No conversations around the table
- HOURS – we will return to our near normal schedule . OFFICIALLY, we are open Friday 9am to 2pm, Saturday 9am to 5pm and Sunday 12 (noon) to 5pm.
