Monthly Meeting, January 4, 2026

Executive Board Members in Attendance:

A total of 18 attended the meeting.

The meeting came to order at 1:05pm.

Motion to approve November 16, 2025 minutes as distributed to club members was seconded and approved unanimously.

Officer/Director Reports

President's Report

Mark Gauntner reported:

- The Archery 201 class starts in the evening. There are 11 signed up for the early session, and 18 are signed up for the second session.
- The Archery 101 and 201 classes, as well as the Cub Run Archers gun show, provide substantial revenue to the Cub Run Archers club.
- An inventory of 3D targets needs to be completed. Volunteers offered to help.

Vice-President's Report

Tom Miller reported:

Secretary's Report

Justice Percell reported:

- There are 96 members on the 2025 roster, and 29 on the 2026 roster.
- The next Cub Run Archers meeting will be February 1, 2026, followed by the Chili Cookoff.

Director of Indoor Archery

Marvin Hicks reported:

- There has been an increase in indoor range activity. Some are bringing their own target butts.
- Target butts for the indoor range have been purchased, and will soon replace current butts.
- Current target butts on the indoor range are composed of a stack of 11 layers. Each layer costs approximately \$110. Total cost is \$1210.
- There is a calendar posted for the indoor range. Users should check the calendar and make additions or corrections as necessary.
- A cleaning crew comes in on Saturday mornings, and the range needs to be closed while they are working. However, the range will not be shut down for long, so the cleaning is not on the calendar.
- There is a continuing lack of payments for targets. A discussion was started on the possible use of Venmo for purchases of targets and other items. (Venmo is an American mobile payment service founded in 2009 and owned by PayPal since 2013.)

- Linda Riemer thanked all who helped with the Christmas banquet.
- The Chili cookoff will follow the meeting on February 1. There are currently three entries, and more are welcome.
